We offer a portfolio of homes for people with a range of complex difficulties and challenges, supporting them to lead their lives in the way they choose.

Our support is designed to maximise people's ability to:

- Have a meaningful presence in their community
- Make their own choices and decisions (even the most important ones)
- Carry out day to day living tasks
- Enjoy a social life and take part in fulfilling leisure activities
- Participate in relationships with their family and others

How do we achieve this?

- Our **six monthly assessments and person centred approach** ensures that we are always in tune with the wishes, aims and aspirations of the individual. This includes leisure interests, education, employment and housing choices.
- Our **Consultant Psychologist and Consultant Psychiatrist spend time to** really understand the person and the individual/environmental influences that may be causing their challenges to occur. From this we develop **positive behavioural support plans** that improve the person's quality of life.
- We know that communication is fundamental, so with the support of our **Speech and Language Therapist** we enable the use of a range of alternative communication methods. This ensures that everyone has the ability to participate and make their own decisions and choices.
- Our dedicated **Development and Activity Co-ordinators** organize a variety of informal leisure activities and accredited development programmes including the **Asdan 'Towards Independence'** and **'Personal Progress'**. Both programmes develop skills needed for successful independent living. Modules are also used as evidence for the skills section of the Duke of Edinburgh Award and the Winslow Award which are also offered.
- We have excellent relationships with **local colleges** who provide outreach courses using facilities (pottery studio, horticulture area) at the homes, as well as working with us to support residents wishing to take courses within the wider college community.
- We consciously help people to build and maintain **social networks** that have meaning for them, to ensure that they have a real place in the community. These networks take into consideration individual interests and/or cultural background.
- We ensure that people receive the **very best healthcare** and have access to the specialist services they require.

West Midlands

Winslow Court

Bromyard, Herefordshire. HR7 4LS

A residential home for twenty six adults, with accommodation across four bungalows, all with their own staff teams. Set within twenty five acres of woodland and countryside overlooking the Malvern Hills, Winslow Court is ideal for people with very complex difficulties and challenges who are looking for a peaceful environment.

Winslow Court is 3 miles from the market town of Bromyard and approximately 15 miles from the cathedral cities of Hereford and Worcester. Winslow Court is approximately 30 minutes drive from Junction 7 of the M5 and a 2.5 hour train journey from London.

Fairfield House

Bleathwood, Nr Ludlow, Herefordshire. SY8 4LF

A community based residential home for seven adults. Set in a rural location, Fairfield House is ideal for people with complex difficulties and challenges looking for a peaceful environment. The Georgian style house is set in six acres of grounds on the Herefordshire/Shropshire border and is conveniently located for Ludlow, 3.5 miles away and Tenbury Wells, 4.5 miles away.

Fairfield House is approximately 35 minutes' drive from junction 3 of the M5 and a 3.5 hour train journey from London.

Orchard End

Auberrow, Wellington, Herefordshire. HR4 8AL

A community based residential home for six adults. Set in a rural location within the Hamlet of Auberrow, Orchard End is ideal for people with complex difficulties and challenges looking for a peaceful environment.

The bungalow is situated in an acre of gardens and is conveniently placed between the market town of Leominster and the Cathedral City of Hereford.

Orchard End is approximately 45 minutes drive from junction 2 of the M50 and 20 minutes from junction 7 M5. The train journey from London would take approximately 3.5 hours.

Park House

28 Sherford Street, Bromyard, Herefordshire. HR7 4DL

A community based home for nine adults. Within easy walking distance of the market town of Bromyard, Park House offers range of accommodation, making it an ideal choice for people with some independent living skills who are looking to continue to develop their skills within a safe and supportive environment.

As well as having four ensuite bedrooms, the house encompasses two semi independent flatlets and a two bedroomed bungalow, which sits within the grounds.

Park House is approximately 20 minutes drive from junction 5 of the M5 and 2.5 hour train journey from London.

Ecclesbourne Lodge

Wirksworth Road, Duffield, Derbyshire. DE56 4AQ

A community based transitional home for up to 10 people across two houses, each with their own staff teams. Set in thirteen acres of land, in a semi rural location close to the village of Duffield, Ecclesbourne Lodge is ideal for people with complex difficulties and challenges requiring specialised 'person centred' support in a caring yet productive environment. Here they will be able to learn practical life skills and take part in a range of community and home based activities, enabling their progress and transition towards a more independent life.

Sheldon House

25 Church Street, Oadby, Leicestershire. LE2 5DB

Sheldon House is a community based residential home for seven adults. Within easy walking distance of the town of Oadby and easy access to all local facilities and modes of transport, Sheldon House is ideal for people with some independent living skills looking to continue to develop their skills within a safe and supportive environment.

Sheldon House is approximately 20 minutes drive from junction 21 of the M1 and a 1.5 hour train journey from London.
