### FAIRFIELD HOUSE

part of the SENAD Group

#### Fairfield House

A community based residential home for six young adults. It is a two storey house with six en-suite rooms, two on the ground floor and four upstairs. It is situated in six acres of grounds on the Herefordshire/Shropshire borders and is conveniently located 3.5 miles from Ludlow, and 4.5 miles from Tenbury Wells. Fairfield House is allied to the parent site of Winslow Court which specialises in the care of young adults with severe learning difficulties and associated challenging behaviours.

### ORCHARD END

#### Orchard End

A community based residential home for five young adults. It is a bungalow with five bedrooms (two en-suites). It is situated in an acre of gardens in the Herefordshire hamlet of Auberrow, conveniently placed between the market town of Leominster and the cathedral city of Hereford. Orchard End is allied to the parent site of Winslow Court which specialises in the care of young adults with severe learning difficulties and associated challenging behaviours.

### PARK HOUSE

#### Park House

Park House is a community based residential home for seven young adults. It is situated in the town of Bromyard within two minutes walk of the town centre. Contained within the main home are two flatlets, which consist of bedroom, lounge and kitchen facilities. This enables residents to live in a semi-supported environment. Park House is allied to the parent site of Winslow Court which specialises in the care of young adults with severe learning difficulties and associated challenging behaviours.

### Features of Our Provision:

- Access to the on and off site training facilities which include, literacy, numeracy, computers, arts and crafts, cookery, music, television, horticulture, walking, cycling, conservation, sport, barbeques and camping.
- Residents have access to communication with family members and significant others, by telephone, the postal service or by e-mail.
- Visits from families or significant others are welcomed at any time.
- Access to the local community via on site transport which includes activities such as money handling, food and personal shopping, trips to public houses, cafes, restaurants, churches, swimming pools, cinema, local events and places of interest in the area.
- Access to local Colleges and Charity Groups
- Access to facilities at Winslow Court which includes gymnasium, pottery, spa pool, art groups, outreach groups, social contact with peers through organised coffee mornings etc.
- The use of Winslow Courts Speech Therapy Department, Psychology Department, site nurse and maintenance team as required. Residents will be registered with the local GP in Hereford.
- Each resident has their own en-suite room.
- Residents receive support from a discrete trained staff team who respect needs, privacy and dignity.
