Rowden House School Profile

Our School:

Rowden House School is set in its own parkland campus 15 miles west of Worcester, providing a peaceful and safe environment for young people with severe learning difficulties combined with difficult and challenging behaviour patterns. Our young people live in purpose built bungalows and The Cottage, with easy access to the modern purpose built school and 16+ teaching areas.

Pupils benefit from the play barn and the new therapeutic playground. Parents, carers and Social Workers can stay at the school's five-bed lodge free of charge when visiting their child.

Pupil Profile:

- Severe learning difficulties with associated challenging behaviour.
- 75% of our pupils are diagnosed with Autistic spectrum disorders
- 25% of our pupils are active epileptics. A further 10% are under investigation or have minor epileptic activity
- Key diagnoses/ behaviours that we can support include Autistic spectrum disorders, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder, Fragile X, Angelman syndrome, Down's syndrome with other associated diagnoses; Tuberous Sclerosis, Diabetic, absconders; Prader Willi syndrome.

Features of Our Provision:

- Approval status: 44 children with learning difficulties
- 38 - 52 week residential provision and day places, with holiday respite available
- Age range 11-19, co-educational
- All facilities of are high quality, on one site and all key facilities are accessible on ground level
- High staff to pupil ratios
- Speech & language therapy and psychology are integrated into a 24 hour curriculum.
- Nursing team further supported by an 'on call' consultant psychiatrist
- Music therapy available
- Access to specialist services through Herefordshire GP service into PCT
- Education is presented in a way that can be accessed by pupils with moderate or severe learning difficulties
- Our young people benefit from the consistency of structures and routine that can be delivered on a single site and ensure the development of skills
- A bespoke package of education and care is created for each individual child
- A focus on achieving life skills, independence skills and social skills, which increases as the young person progresses through the curriculum
- Externally accredited national courses through ASDAN Transition Challenge (KS4) then ASDAN towards Independence (16+). The most able 16+ young people complete ASDAN Bronze Award.
