Residential care for young adults:

Winslow Court is a residential centre for adults with severe learning difficulties and challenging behaviour. Set within 26 acres of woodland in the heart of Herefordshire overlooking the Malvern hills, Winslow Court is 3 miles from the market town of Bromyard and approximately 15 miles from the cathedral cities of Hereford and Worcester.

Resident Profile:

- Severe learning difficulties with associated challenging behaviours
- Residents who need routines and structure to enable the development of skills
- 70% of our residents have been diagnosed with ASD
- 25% of our residents have epilepsy to varying degrees
- Key diagnoses/behaviours which are being successfully provided for on site or in the past: ASD, ADHD, Fragile X, Anglemans syndrome, Prader Willi syndrome, Cornelia DeLang, Absconders, Visual impairment.

- Registered as an Adult Residential Care Home with the CSCI for 24 adults
- Age range 18 to 30
- Mixed gender
- 52 week placements
- Winslow Court is a purpose designed high specification development
- All the units are single storey and incorporate independent accommodation for each of our clients

- Integrated speech and language therapy and psychology departments
- Music therapy if required
- Nursing team available supported by Consultant Psychiatrist
